FFC - FLOATS AND FUEL CELLS, INC OF MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE RECEIVES BELL 206B III PMA

FFC Manufacturing received Parts Manufacturing Approval to manufacture replacement Bell 206 B III main fuel cells (Bell P/N 206-061-661-101 or 206-061-661-103).

Floats and Fuel Cells, Inc. is a Memphis Tennessee Fuel Tank Manufacturer. Kevin Brewer, Director of Sales and Marketing for Floats and Fuel Cells, Inc., announced that the FAA has granted FFC Manufacturing the approval to manufacture replacement fuel bladders for the Bell 206 B III helicopter. This is the latest approval for FFCM bringing the total number of PMA's for the organization to 206.

In 2008, FFC obtained TSO-C80 approval for its P2595 Commercial Crash-resistant fuel cell construction. The P2595 construction surpassed OEM standards with total compliance of 14CFR, Part 27.965. and that approval has now resulted in the organization's first commercial crash-resistant fuel cell PMA. Brewer commented, "We are very excited about the organization's opportunities with replacement helicopter fuel cells and this approval will only be the first of many to come."
